



Regional Knowledge Leaders training program

What is the training for?

In the Regional Knowledge Leaders training program NRM staff learn why their region or organisation can benefit from a Regional Knowledge Strategy and how to facilitate Strategy development process (see over page). There are still places available at up-coming trainings.

Is there a cost for the training?

The training is free-of-charge to one or possibly two staff per region, and participants will be assisted with travel and other attendance costs (depending on overall numbers and the nature of the region, it may be possible to provide training free-of-charge to more than two people per region).

Am I eligible to participate?

We welcome participants with good facilitation skills whose position would enable them to facilitate the development of a Regional Knowledge Strategy. To be eligible to participate you need to be:

- an employee of, or contractor to, one of Australia's 56 regional NRM bodies and endorsed in writing by your CEO or General Manager as being **the most suitable person/people from your region** to participate; or
- a regional liaison officer or similar with one of Australia's Rural R&D Corporations or other similar NRM or R&D organisation that works with regional NRM bodies.

How long is the training?

Each training workshop will be 2 days in length, and participants will need to attend the whole workshop.
